

The WSJ/Vistage Small Business CEO Confidence Index continues to slowly rise, driven by optimistic revenue and profit expectations


Over half of small businesses are offering work from home options to accommodate back to school plans

Small business approach to employee impact of local back to school plans	
My employees can work from home as long as they need to	55%
Other (not impacted, case-by-case, varies by positions)	20%
We are helping employees find childcare or creating our own arrangements to allow them to come back to work	10%
I'm asking employees to come back to work at a specific date, no exceptions	8%
I'm giving employees with children a specific time period to find alternative childcare plans	8%



Small business optimism about future economic improvements hits plateau in August


Percentage of CEOs who expect improvement to the U.S. economy over next 12 months

Revenue projections for small businesses continue to rise despite economic optimism hitting a plateau




