

The WSJ/Vistage Small Business CEO Confidence Index rose for the fifth consecutive month in September to double the April low of 44.7






Small business optimism about the future of the U.S. economy jumps 15 points in September

Percentage of CEOs who expect improvement to the U.S. economy over next 12 months






Revenue projections for small businesses rebound to levels recorded in March





More than six times as many small businesses expect revenue increases than those that expect declines


Revenue expectations of small business CEOs over the next 12 months






Expansion plans for small businesses regain momentum in September

Percentage of CEOs that plan to increase investments, workforce






Workforce expansion plans jump 11 points in September; 47% of small businesses plan expansion in next 3 months





While 30% report they have recovered, the majority of small businesses expect recovery in 6 months or greater


Expectations for business recovery from pandemic impacts
